

# MAPPING EUROPE: CHECKLIST

## General Directions

1. Read ALL directions for each section before labeling your map. To complete this map, you will need *Ultra fine-point Sharpie markers in red, black, blue, brown, and dark green* along with a box of colored pencils and a ruler.
2. All labels should be made horizontally inside the item or, if it won't fit, connected with a straight line from the label to the item. Labels with lines connecting to the spot can be put in the ocean or in the margin. No lines should cross over other lines. However, mountain range labels may follow the range. Do not write a label over or through another label.
3. MAPS to use – Textbook p. 248, 255, 261, 274, 287; Atlas pgs. 78-113

## Countries and Capitals

- Lightly shade each country using different colored pencils. Alternate colors so that no countries touching each other have the same color.
- Then label the countries using an Ultra fine-point black Sharpie. Do not write the name of the country over the location of the capital since you will be marking that too. **Note: There is a numbering system for small countries. Just write the number where the country is located instead of the country name. The key is below this list of other countries.**
- Mark the location of each capital city with a small red star.

### **Key for very small Countries and Capitals**

**Write the number on the map in Ultra fine-tip black Sharpie. Do not write the name of the country or capital.**

1 = Luxembourg (Luxembourg)

2 = Liechtenstein (Vaduz)

3 = Andorra (Andorra la Vella)

4 = Kosovo (Pristina)

5 = Montenegro (Podgorica)

6 = Monaco (Monaco)

7 = San Marino (San Marino)

8 = Vatican City

9 = Malta (Valletta)

**Islands – Color and outline each island with the same color as the country that owns it, unless it is a separate country. Label with an Ultra fine-tip black Sharpie.**
